

## California Consumer Privacy Act Notice

The following information is exclusively provided for individuals that are residents of the State of California (a “Consumer”) and is made pursuant to the requirements of the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018, as amended (the “CCPA”).

### **Types of Information We May Collect**

Through our Site, we may collect information (hereinafter, “Personal Information”) that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a Consumer. The CCPA’s definition of Personal Information does not include publicly available information, such as information found in publicly available federal, state, or local government records.

### **Your CCPA Rights**

The CCPA provides individuals who are residents of the State of California (i.e. Consumers) with the following rights relating to their Personal Information:

#### **-Right To Request To Know About Personal Information We Collected**

If you are a Consumer, you may specifically request and, except where certain exceptions apply, we will disclose the following information to you about your Personal Information that we have collected and used over the past 12 months: (a) the specific pieces of Personal Information we collected about you; (b) the categories of Personal Information we collected about you; (c) the categories of sources from which the Personal Information is collected about you; (d) our business or commercial purpose for collecting or selling that Personal Information; (e) the categories of third parties with whom we share that Personal Information; and (f) if we sold or disclosed your Personal Information for a business purpose.

You may specifically request the above information from us twice in a twelve (12) month period and we will provide the information, free of charge, following receipt of a verifiable request. Instructions on how to make a verifiable request are set forth below.

#### **-Right To Request Deletion Of Your Personal Information We Collected**

If you are a Consumer, you may specifically request and, except where certain exceptions apply, we will delete your Personal Information that we have collected about you following receipt of a verifiable request. Instructions on how to make a verifiable request are set forth below.

#### **-How To Exercise Your Right To Request To Know And/Or Your Right To Request Deletion**

Only you, or an authorized agent registered with the California Secretary of State that you authorize to act on your behalf, may make a consumer request related to your Personal Information. We reserve the right to confirm that the party requesting to know and/or requesting to delete Personal Information is the Consumer about whom the request relates in order to process the request. We will only use Personal Information provided in a Consumer request to verify the Consumer's identity or the party's authority to make the request on behalf of a Consumer.

We do not charge a fee to process or respond to your verified request to know and/or your verified request to delete unless it is excessive or manifestly unfounded. If we determine that

the request warrants a fee, we will tell you why we made that decision and provide you with a cost estimate before completing your request(s).

**- No Discrimination For Exercising Your CCPA Rights**

We will not discriminate against you for exercising any of the rights provided by the CCPA to a Consumer. We will not: (a) deny goods or services to you; (b) charge you different prices or rates for goods or services, including through granting discounts or other benefits, or imposing penalties; (c) provide you a different level or quality of goods or services; or (d) suggest that you will receive a different price or rate for goods or services or a different level or quality of goods or services.

**California Civil Code Section § 1798.83**

Separate and apart from the CCPA, California Civil Code Section § 1798.83 permits users of the Site that are California residents to request certain information regarding our disclosure of Personal Information to third parties for their direct marketing purposes.
